Rainbow Foundation India organized a First Aid training on training for all the staff of Sanrakshan Rainbow Home. Wherein, Dr. Nagarjun K P, from Sri Srinivasa Health Care Academy gave a detailed introduction to CPR, Safety considerations, and ABC techniques and provided hands-on experiences to encourage them to practice until they feel confident in their abilities.

### **Training on SJPU& POCSO**

Training on SJPU (Special Juvenile Police Unit) and POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offences) is crucial for a social workers, who work with children. ECHO organization has organized Training for all the SJPU workers wherein, Mr. Lokesh, Ms. Geetha (ACP), Baju Thamas(advocate) and Mr. shravan Kumar(Advocate) and Ms. Usha (Counsellor) Spoke about Child rights and Protection, Provisions under POCSO act, Child friendly Justice system, Interagency collaboration with SJPU, Child protection agencies, Health care providers, and other stakeholders in responding to cases of child sexual abuse.

They also spoke about counseling techniques, reporting, legal and Ethical Considerations.
