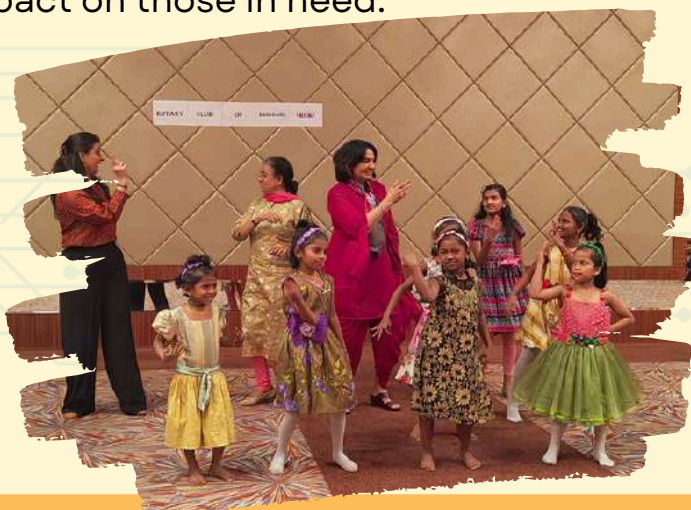
Health Camp
