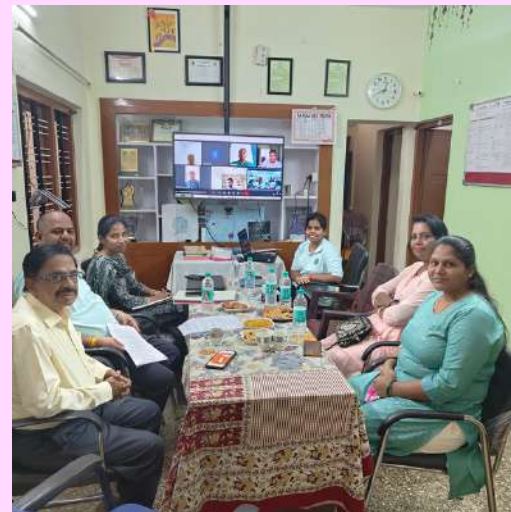


## Visit from DCPU, Yelahanka
